



Public and Product Liability Insurance A Group Liability policy for Potters and other craft workers

The Australian Ceramics Association has negotiated a group insurance scheme to provide Public Liability and Product Liability cover to *Association Members* for;

- Professional, non-professional potters &/or other craft workers who make or sell their products, including those who sell at craft markets or through other retail outlets.
- Those who teach their craft to groups of 20 persons or less,
- Those who demonstrate their craft or exhibit to the general public for a fee,
- Those who design and make their product provided that no separate *design fee* is charged.

It is **NOT** intended for

- Distributors selling a non craft product produced by third parties.
- Enterprises with more than three (3) people working in them
- Sale or supply of products *imported or exported* by you
- Sale or supply of products (not made by you) and wholesaled to others
- Sale or supply of any other product which is *not* craft related

Limit of Indemnity:

Public Liability	\$10,000,000
Product Liability	\$10,000,000
Tenants Liability	\$10,000,000
Property in physical & legal control	\$ 20,000
Excess	\$ 1,000
